Sarah's Food Drive: donations are welcome every day next week! The School Challenge officially starts on Monday.

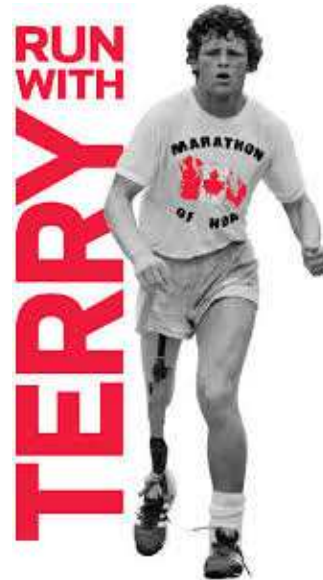
