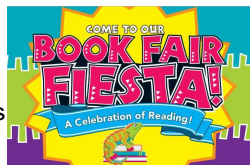
Important: Toronto Police has indicated it is difficult to find Crossing Guards. If you are (or know somebody) interested, please contact Principal Ehrlich!
